# Mātauranga Māori within New Zealand Libraries

## METHODOLOGY

The workshop is facilitated by Te Rōpū Whakahau and delivered by Māori Librarians and Information Management specialists. Where necessary the services of kaumātua, kuia and other experts may support sessions within the construct of the course .

It is an interactive programme focused on providing participants with practical examples and/ or information to ensure that you can readily transfer what you learn back in the workplace. Group discussions, exercises , examples and programme information is supplied.

This workshop is designed as a full one day workshop from 9.00am – 5.00pm. All participants are to commit the entire day to this workshop and on completion participants will receive a Certificate of Completion.
