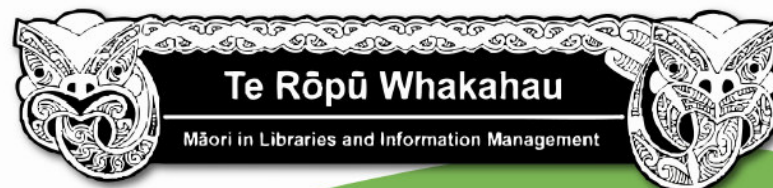
Transport: Airport - Marae Arrangements for transport between airport & marae are being organised for Wednesday/Saturday. Please contact for more information.
